



## Tip #8: Tree Stand Height



Time to become a tree hugger and hang some stands.

Hanging a tree stand is all about getting out of the deer's line of sight. A good tree stand height can be anywhere from 10-30 feet high, depending on the terrain.



Hilly terrain can always present some problems with hanging a stand, but if you just remember to keep out of the deer's normal line of sight, you will be good.



Better place your stand higher here.



You're good to go here. Uphill side of a trail will usually be a better bet to place your stand.



And yes, deer will look up if you give them a reason to.
